NSSCH TOP 20 CANDIDATES HL NATIONALLY 2019 – MORE RESULTS



Maurice Hinterholzer achieved 1st place Nationally HL in First Language Afrikaans, First Language English, Biology, Physical Science, Mathematics and Accounting.

He was placed 8th in Geography, his 7th subject as well as 1st Top Candidate in the Erongo Region and in the country, with 94.775%.



Michelle du Plessis was placed 7th place Nationally HL in First Language Afrikaans, 2nd in Mathematics, 8th in Accounting as well as 2nd Top Candidate in the Erongo Region and 10th in the country with 90.438%.



Zurialle de Bairos was placed 13th Nationally in Biology HL and 1st in Design and Technology HL.

In Afrikaans as a Second Language, Caitlin Gerber was placed 4th, Milandie Krauze 14th and Daniel Allen 20th. In Design and Technology, Thomas de Jager was further placed 2nd, Anneli Janse van Rensburg 3rd, Wayne Profit 4th, John Faul 6th, Wilbert Derks 7th, Dylan Ingram 8th, Raquel dos Santos 9th, Dehan van der Merwe 10th, Albertus de Klerk 11th, Ethen Visagie von Solms 15th, Caitlin Gerber 16th and Giandre Cordier 18th.

Apart from Maurice Hinterholzer achieving 1st place in the Erongo Region in Higher Level subjects, and Michelle du Plessis 2nd, John Faul was placed 4th, Idelette Liebenberg 6th, Wayne Profit 7th, Sue-Melle Mans 8th, Caitlin Gerber 9th, Anneli Janse van Rensburg 10th, Victor van der Watt 14th, Milandie Krauze 17th and Daniel Allen 18th. In Ordinary Level subjects Valdeo Dreyer was placed 5th in the Erongo Region with Wilke Ferreira 7th. Indeed excellent!

WBPHS was placed 5th Nationally of all schools in 2019 from 8th in 2018 in the NSSCH examinations. WBPHS was placed 11th Nationally of all schools from 20th in 2018 in the NSSCO examination.
