NSSC ORDINARY & AS LEVELS

Our Grade 11 learners are well into their Senior Secondary Phase. We have a group that is preparing for their end of year external NSSCO examination. These results will determine which subjects they will be allowed to take in their AS year. The group of Grade 11 learners in the O Lane have slowed down their teaching pace so that the learners can practice more on a topic. These learners will write their NSSCO external examination in 2021. Information evenings will be scheduled for the Grade 11 parents to answer any queries regarding the new curriculum. The accreditation by Cambridge remains.


