There will be CrossFit, karate, running and cycling, vehicle exhibitions, jumping castles, stalls, a flea market, live music, tasty food and a beer tent to keep the whole family entertained during the Standard Bank Desert Festival to be held on the first weekend of October.



Supervision will be arranged for Gr. R - Gr. 7 learners.




Baie geluk aan Michael de Waal en Tristan Klaasse vir hulle voltalle!!
