






CONGRATULATIONS TO THE TEAMS, PLAYERS AND COACHES! YOU MAKE WBPS PROUD.

We finally made our way to the paintball centre in anticipation of the games we would play. Each of the four groups were named and had a battle cry to add to the fun.


Mr Philip van Niekerk's team won, but the best player of the day - Bianca Hannabus - made the girls proud.




