2018 EXTERNAL GRADE 12 NSSC RESULTS CONTINUE



We are delighted to announce that Charlize van Zyl has been awarded the first place in the Erongo Region and 25th in the country in the NSSCH and NSSCO results of 2018 with her five 1-gradings and one 2-grading. She further achieved 4th place for Accounting, and 16th for Afrikaans 2nd Language HL in the country. Charlize is enrolled at the North West University at the Potchefstroom campus, busy with her Degree in the Bed Foundation Phase Degree.
